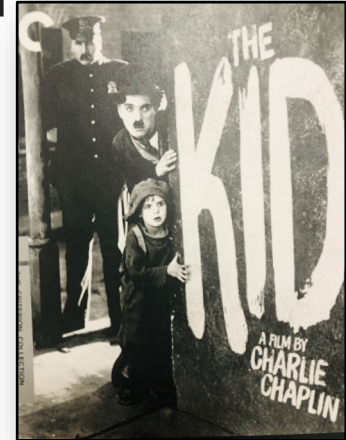
“Making the world smile again”
