#### Minimum Requirements to participate in the STAR construction readiness program

- High School Diploma/ GED/ or equivalent
- At least 18 years of age by the first day of class
- Legally eligible to work in the United States without sponsorship
- Willingness to sign, and adhere to, Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)
- Pass a Background Check & Drug Test prior to being accepted in the program and then again upon employment
  - o Minimum criteria: Level 2+ through OneSource
    - Search for misdemeanors within 5 years, felonies within 7 years
    - Not on the sexual offenders registry or watch list
    - Screen for up to 10 drugs
- Meet physical fitness requirements of job description (example below)
- Strong work ethic
- Willingness to learn
- Good communication skills
- Demonstrated interpersonal skills
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision and/pr while following directions set by a supervisor
- Valid Driver's License or ability to get one
- Ability to make it to the training/job site daily and on-time

### Work Based Knowledge, Skills, and Physical Requirements

- Moderate technical abilities including the utilization of a smartphone/tablet and supported software
- Able to stand, walk lift/lower/carry weight 25-50 lbs, reaching below shoulder height, bending/twisting neck, bending at the waist (forward & sideways), balancing, pushing/pulling, repetitive motion, hand/wrist flexion-extension, noise/dust/chemical exposures, reaching above shoulder heights, squatting, kneeling, climbing, working on heights
- Must be able to comprehend safety instructions and signage, communicate effectively in emergency situations and understand written safety instructions from tool and equipment manufacturers
- Communication, math and reading skills
- Written communications requiring basic grammar skills
- Interact with customers on an explanatory basis
- Interact with groups of people; co-workers, internal and external customers
- Use of telephones, public address systems
- Basic skills of addition, subtraction and multiplication
